developments is the college’s use of reclaimed water to meet most of the irrigation needs around campus.



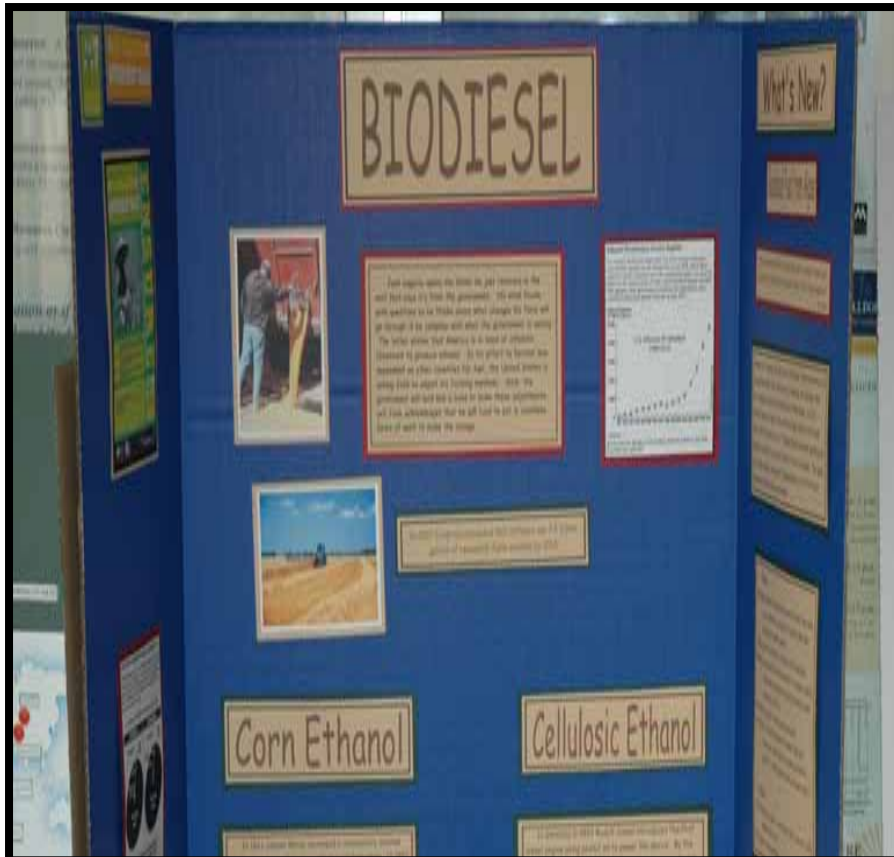

Bruce Scharbach, the Facilities Services Supervisor at CGCC, tells us that based on the current cost per gallon of drinkable water the college will save approximately \$19,783 per year. These savings will happen by using less drinkable water which is quite a bit more expensive than reclaimed wa-

ter. Based on the current cost of 40,000 gallons of water annually per fixture, and as Scharbach remarks, “creating savings that literally won’t go down the drain.”

By following this example that CGCC has wholeheartedly began to set into motion, you can also start saving resources and money. Transform the property
