

Frequently Asked Questions About the Learning College Summit

What is appropriate attire for the Summit?

Business casual is appropriate attire. The Summit is held in June, and although temperatures outside may be warm, the meeting rooms are air conditioned and can be quite cool. We recommend bringing a sweater or jacket, or dressing in layers, to help ensure your personal comfort.

What meals are included in the registration fee?

Summit registration includes a continental breakfast on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday mornings, June 9-11, and lunch on Monday and Tuesday, June 9-10.

Where do I pick up the complimentary evening shuttle?

Complimentary shuttle service is provided to local restaurant areas the evenings of June 8, 9, and 10. The shuttle picks up at the front entrance to the Doubletree Hotel Overland Park-Corporate Woods. On Sunday, June 8, the shuttle route will include the opening reception at the Nerman Museum of Contemporary Art.
